## Communication Strategies and Tools

GroupMe will be used as the main method of communication as a group. Any messages sent during the work week should be responded to within 3 hours amount of time. If the message is sent after 9 PM, the previously stated rule does not stand, but is reinitiated at 9 AM. Similarly, messages sent during weekends have a 3-hour max response time; however, the rule does not stand for messages sent after 10 PM but is reinstated at 12 PM. A 'like' of a message may be used as a way to show recognition of a message and can be considered a response. In the case of a technical issue of GroupMe not working for one or all members, email may be used to communicate. In this case, all members must be sent the email or CC'd.

## Impromptu Meetings Expectations

An impromptu meeting may be called at any time, but all members of the team must agree upon a time so every person may attend. In the case an impromptu meeting is called, it must be called at least 24 hours in advance and a decision of meeting time and place must be figured out within 3 hours. If there is no time that all team members can meet in person, a meeting may be conducted using Discord.

## Mentor Expectations

Mentor meetings will be held to present group progress. To show progress, the following must be presented at each meeting:

- **Task Report**  
This report details weekly progress of the team, including meetings that occurred, completed tasks, tasks currently in progress, and upcoming tasks.
- **Gantt Chart**  
This chart provides a visual representation of the team's progress and should be updated weekly.
- **GitHub Commit Statistics**  
Report of the team's commit statistics that will show how each individual team member has committed.
